Entry Information

Entry fee (per trial) 15.00 per class per dog. (includes \$3.00 AKC recording fee)

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have obtained AKC ILP or PAL numbers, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance.

A refund of one-half the entry fee will be given for bitches who come in season after entries close, provided the request is made in writing (e-mail okay) before the commencement of judging each day. No refunds will be given for amounts under \$10.

Course Familiarization and Warm-Ups

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. A walk-through period will be held prior to each class, following the judge's briefing. A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, shall be provided for all exhibitors.

AKC no longer allows novice equipment familiarization.

Move-Ups

Move-Ups after entries close must be submitted, in writing, to the Trial Secretary, by 6 pm PST, November 2, 2009. Day to day moveups will be allowed at this trial. Moveups must be turned in within 30 minutes of completion of judging each day.

Hospitality Information

There will be coffee and breakfast items for exhibitors each morning. Lunch will be provided for workers at the trial. Non-workers may partake of the lunch after the volunteers have eaten, and are expected to make a reasonable donation. There will be no food vendors at the trial. The closest fast food is in Black Diamond, Enumclaw, or Auburn.

General Show Rules

- The Sno-King Agility Club and Argus Ranch assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, spectators, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of his or her parents or guardians.
- Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, telephone, FAX or telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC forms or photocopies of AKC forms without the agreement and rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC entry form are not acceptable.
- Owners are responsible for errors on entry blanks. Dogs incorrectly entered may not be transferred to another class after entries close.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in event of errors or cancellation of entries after the closing date, or in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, fire, Act of God, act of a public enemy, strikes, or any other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show no refund of entry fee(s) will be made.
- Confirmation of entry and schedule of judging time will be sent to the e-mail address on the Official AKC entry form after closing date. *If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the Schedule within seven days of the show, contact the Trial Secretary.*
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. There will be a \$20 service charge for any checks returned NSF.

Exhibitor Information

- *All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.*
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendations to assure dogs are free from parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- These Agility Trials will be held indoors on dirt. We will be running two rings simultaneously.

Height Cards

Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of Regulations for Agility Trials.

AGILITY CLASSES

Please see the AKC regulations for agility trials for current class descriptions. Dogs must be entered only in Regular classes or Preferred classes, with no crossover allowed between them at the same set of trials (weekend.)

Classes offered

Classes offered include:

- Standard – Novice A & B, Open, Excellent A & B
- Standard Preferred – Novice, Open, Excellent A & B
- Jumpers with Weaves – Novice A & B, Open, Excellent A & B
- Jumpers with Weaves Preferred – Novice, Open, Excellent A & B

Height Divisions

Regular classes

- 8 inches - For dogs 11 inches and under at the withers
- 12 inches - For dogs 14 inches and under at the withers
- 16 inches - For dogs 18 inches and under at the withers
- 20 inches - For dogs 22 inches and under at the withers.
- 24 inches - For dogs over 22 inches at the withers.
- 26 inches – Handler's option

Preferred Classes:

- 4 Inches: For dogs 11 inches and under at the withers.
- 8 Inches: For dogs 14 inches and under at the withers.
- 12 Inches: For dogs 18 inches and under at the withers.
- 16 Inches: For dogs 22 inches and under at the withers.
- 20 Inches: For dogs over 22 inches at the withers.

NOTE – Dogs must jump their indicated height in Preferred classes – they do not have the option of jumping at a higher height.

Prize And Award Information

- First Prize - Blue Rosette
- Second Prize - Red Rosette
- Third Prize - Yellow Rosette
- Fourth Prize - White Rosette
- Qualifying Score - Dark Green Rosette

A special rosette will be given for any dog completing a title at this trial. A special rosette and a jump bar will be given for any dog completing a MACH or a PAX title.

Qualifying Score required for all prizes.

Directions to the show

From I-5 North or South. Take the Auburn exit (Highway 18) Exit to Auburn-Black Diamond Road eastbound. Turn right immediately onto SE Green Valley Road (just past Neely Mansion). Go approx 7.5 miles. Turn right onto 212th Avenue SE (just after the green bridge sitting on dry land on your right). Take first left just after crossing river into Argus. The arena will be on your right.

From I-405 Southbound. Go south on Maple Valley Highway (Highway 169), into Black Diamond. Turn right on Roberts Road (look for Coal Car). Go approximately 4 miles.

Watch your speed in Black Diamond – THEY CHECK! Turn left onto 218th Street. At the bottom of the long hill is a stop sign. Go straight across the bridge at the Green River and take the first left into Argus Ranch driveway.
